To remove the tefillin, stand and unwind the strap from the fingers, and wind it temporarily around the palm. Remove the head tefillin and replace it in the box, wrapping the straps neatly. Unwrap the hand and arm tefillin, replace it in its box and wrap the strap neatly.
